

Resolution to accept a new gate at Lampman Park

Eugene Weir of the Freshwater Trust has agreed to spend \$2,700 to install a gate at the downstream end of the parking area of Lampman Park to help control illegal dumping. The city must agree to put up some boulders or other barriers on either side of the gate during the next year. The Parks Commission voted in favor of the idea and recommends that the city approve the installation of the gate.

Resolution to support Ti'lomikh Falls as the venue for the L.A. 2028 Olympic whitewater competition

The Gold Hill Whitewater Park has been open since 2014 and has hosted many events including the King of the Rogue Race and the US Rafting Championship. In 2016, the City approved the whitewater modifications in the Gold Hill Parks Plan and the City applied for a \$750,000 State Parks grant to help pay for the work. Permitting for the whitewater modifications was delayed by COVID but is moving forward. The question now is whether the City is willing to support reaching out to the Los Angeles Olympic Committee to have Gold Hill considered as a venue for the 2028 Olympic Games.
