5.06.010 Defined. The term "yard sale" is defined for the purpose of this chapter to be the offering of personal property for sale, by any person, at the residence within the city and includes, but is not limited to, those sales commonly known as yard sales, garage sales or patio sales. (Ord. 87-009 §1 (part), 1987).

5.06.020 Permits. No person shall hold a yard sale within the city without first applying for and obtaining a permit for the sale. Applications require the name and address of applicant, as well as the date and the hours sale will be held. Permits shall be issued by the city recorder for a fee as set by Section 5. 04. 075, and shall be valid for a period of three days. All such permits shall be issued with a copy of Section 5.06.030, Rules and regulations relating to yard sales. Yard sales are exempt from the business license requirements of Chapter 5. 04. (Ord. 541 §4 (part), 2001: Ord. 87-009 §1 (part), 1987).

5.06.030 Rules and regulations relating to yard sales. All yard sales shall comply with the following rules and regulations:

A. No resident of the city shall hold more than four yard sales within any twelve-month period, nor shall more than four yard sales be held at any residence within any twelve-month period.

B. A yard sale shall last no more than three consecutive days and shall be held only between the hours of eight a.m. and nine p.m. without special permission from the city recorder.

C. All yard sales shall be conducted in a manner so as to cause no inconvenience or annoyance to the residents of the neighborhood and shall be conducted without the creation of excessive noise, air or water pollution, or any unsightly condition in the neighborhood.

D. All signs must state the location of sale, i.e., name and address, as well as the date and hours of sale. Signs shall be removed within twenty-four hours of end of sale. (Ord. 87-009 §1 (part), 1987).

5.06.040 Penalties. Violation of any provisions of this chapter shall be a Class B violation. Each day in which a violation occurs shall be considered to be a separate offense. (Ord. 541 §5 (part), 2001: Ord. 87-009 §1(part), 1987).
