From the Mayor

Code Enforcement – City Council passed an ordinance this month authorizing the vigorous enforcement of our rules surrounding public safety and cleanliness. If you are out of compliance, you may be hit with a fine of up to \$250 a day.

Section 8.40.010 Violation - Penalties

Except in cases where a different punishment is prescribed by ordinance, any person violating any of the provisions of this chapter or failing to comply with any of the mandatory requirements of the ordinances of the city shall be punished by a fine of not more than two hundred fifty dollars. Each such person is guilty of a separate offense for each and every day during any portion of which any violation of any provision of the ordinances is committed, continued, or permitted by any such person. If the fine is not paid, nor the violation resolved to the satisfaction of the Municipal Judge, the violator shall then be referred to the Abatement Procedure (8.08.130).

Do we want to fine people? No. Will we? Yes. Don't make us be the bad guy, clean up your yard! Specifically, we will cite houses with the following in their yards: cars, appliances, garbage, weeds over 10 inches high.

Treasure Hunt - July 3 from noon- 3 pm @ Riverside Beach Park

Mark your calendars for July 3 when the ghost of Clem Hawkins appears to reveal The Lost Treasure of Gold Hill. This exciting interactive adventure is for children aged 5 - 11. It begins when the ghost of an 1850s miner announces he is ready to give his hidden treasure to children who are worthy — worthiness they must prove by undergoing three trials. Along the way they encounter the Game Master where they prove their skill, the Quiz Master where they prove their wisdom, and then they journey through the Sea of Peril where they prove their courage. At the end of the trials they are awarded a victory medallion and treasure map. Following clues, they finally discover the treasure's location and dig up small chests near our river beach.

This fun-filled adventure takes place on July 3, 2021, 12:00 noon, beginning at Lucky's (336 Second Avenue in Gold Hill) and ending at the riverside picnic grounds. Starting times range from 12 noon to 3 PM and the hunt takes about an hour. Because of the number of treasure chests available, the event is limited to the first 200 children. We ask that all youngsters be accompanied by a parent or responsible adult. This special event is **FREE**
