Unfortunately, we are still experiencing bugs with the new credit card processing system, and are unable to accept credit card payments at this time. It should be up and running shortly, but in the meantime, don't worry! We will not be charging late fees if you are unable to pay your bill due to our software glitches.
- Our Municipal Judge has been sworn in, and Court is in . session. We are now writing tickets for code violations within the City limits. This includes a \$25 fine for parking in the Sports Park without paying the \$4 parking fee. Annual passes are available in City Hall for \$20, or \$10 if you are a senior citizen, veteran, or disabled. These fees help pay for the park upkeep.
