

NOTICE OF ELECTION

The period for filing a petition for the November 8, 2022 General Election for positions as Gold Hill City Officers is now open.

The positions to be voted on:

City Councilor (4) four year term, ending December 31, 2026

City Councilor (4) four year term, ending December 31, 2026

City Councilor (4) four year term, ending December 31, 2026

Mayor (2) two year term, ending December 31, 2024

The requirements for filing for any of these positions are as follows:

- 1. The candidate must be a registered voter of the city of Gold Hill; and
- 2. The candidate must reside within the City limits for a minimum of twelve months prior to the election date (November 8, 2022).

The required number of signatures required to complete the Petition for filing for a candidacy for Nonpartisan Nomination is 20, per City Code; and signatures must be verified by the Jackson County Elections Division.

The forms can be picked up at City Hall 420 6th Avenue, Gold Hill, OR 97525 beginning on <u>June 27</u>, <u>2022</u>. Verified petitions must be submitted to the Gold Hill City Recorder by <u>1:00 PM, Friday</u>, <u>August 26th, 2022</u> to qualify for the November 8, 2022 ballot.

Persons interested in filing for any of these positions may obtain the necessary forms at Gold Hill City Hall, 420 6th Avenue, Gold Hill during normal business hours, Monday through Friday 9:00AM to 4:00PM.
