

RESOLUTION 20-R-08

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF GOLD HILL TO DECLARE LEGAL HOLIDAYS AND CLOSING OF CITY HALL TO OBSERVE THE HOLIDAY

WHEREAS, THE CITY Council of the City of Gold Hill has the vested authority and power to regulate working conditions and standards for the City staff, and

WHEREAS, the City has established a standard to observe all federally-recognized holidays.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the following days shall be declared as legal holidays for FY2020-21 and that the City Hall shall be officially closed for business for the observance of these holidays:

July 3 – Independence Day (observed)	September 7 – Labor Day
October 12 – First Nations Day	November 11 – Veteran's Day
November 26 – Thanksgiving	November 27 – Day After Thanksgiving
December 25 – Christmas Day	January 1 – New Year's Day
January 18 – Martin Luther King, Jr. Day	February 15 – President's Day
May 31 – Memorial Day
